

Autumn Splendor Wrap




With a design that reminds one of the golden leaves of Autumn, this wrap is perfect for the slightly cool evenings of Fall and early Spring.

The wrap is easily adjusted for length and width depending on your preferences.

Errata 5/16/13: Updated Gauge and Length note to change repeat from 24 to 12 sts. Change doesn't affect the final base row count. Changes in italics. Added symbol chart.

Sizes and Materials List ...

Size:	15" x 54" [60"] after blocking
Hook(s):	US I/9 (5.5 mm)
Yarn:	Naturally Caron Country [75% Acrylic, 25% Merino Wool, 185 yds/85 g skein]
Colors & Approx. Yardage	0011 Gilded Age, 370 [410] yds (2 [3] skeins)
Notions	Yarn Needle
Gauge:	<p>Pattern rep = 3" l. x 2.5" w. Pattern rep = On base row of 12 sts + 1 st, rows 2-5 <i>Always take time to check your gauge</i></p>
	 <p>EASY</p>
Notes ...	
Length	To increase the length, add 12 sts (3") for each additional pattern rep, for example, for a wrap that is 84" long - $84/3=28$ reps so $28*12=336+1=337$.

Single Crochet (sc)
Double Crochet (dc)

Instructions ...

Wrap

Foundation Row Method 1: Ch 218 [242], sc in second ch from hk and in ea ch across. (217 [241] sc)
Method 2: Sc foundation row of 217 [241].

Row 1 Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), turn, 2 dc in first sc, sk 2 sc, sc in next sc, *ch 5, sk 5 sc, sc in next sc, sk 2, 5 dc in next sc, sk 2 sc, sc in next sc,* rep from * to * to last 3 sc, 3 dc in last sc.

Row 2 Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 5, sc in first ch 5 lp, *ch 5, sc in third dc of shell, ch 5, sc in next ch 5 lp,* rep from * to * to end with the last sc in 3rd ch of beg dc.

Row 3 Ch 5 (beg dc plus 2), turn, sc in first ch 5 lp, *5 dc in next sc, sc in next ch 5 lp, ch 5, sc in next ch 5 lp,* rep from * to * to last ch 5 lp, ch 2, dc in last sc.

Row 4 Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, *ch 5, sc in third dc of shell, ch 5, sc in next ch 5 lp,* rep from * to * to end with last sc in the top of beg dc.

Row 5 Ch 3 (counts as beg dc), turn, 2 dc in first sc, sc in first ch 5 lp, ch 5, sc in next ch 5 lp, *5 dc in next sc, sc in next ch 5 lp, ch 5, sc in next ch 5 lp,* rep from * to * last ch 5 lp, 3 dc in third ch of last ch 5 lp.

Rows 6+ Rep rows 2 through 5 until piece measures approx. 15" when slightly stretched, ending with row 4 (1 rep of row 1, 5 reps of rows 2-5, 1 rep of rows 2-4). To make piece wider, rep rows 2 through 5 as many times as needed to preferred width.

Edging

Row 1 Turn, *ch 2, sc in ch 5 lp, 3 times,* rep from * to * in ea ch 5 loop across to last loop, ch 2, sc in last sc.

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Row 2

Ch 1, turn, sl st in first loop, *ch 2, sc in next ch 2 loop,* rep from * to * across ending with a sc in last ch 1 loop, fasten off.

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Stitch Legend

○	ch 1 chain	+	sc foundation
○	double crochet	+	single crochet
○	triple crochet	●	sl st
+	single crochet	—	pattern rep

Pattern rep is 12 sts (3" in gauge).
Determine number of reps times 12,
plus 1 st to determine base row count.
