A quick lacy shawlette that can be worn around the shoulders or snuggled up around the neck as a cozy warm layer with a coat.

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## Notes ...

| Construction | Pattern is worked from a long foundation with each row being reduced on the ends by <br> one fan and increases in the center for the shaping. Side edging is worked with each <br> row until final 2 rows, which create the bottom edging. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Foundation is worked with the smaller hook, Body of shawl uses the larger hook. <br> To increase size of shawlette add multiples of 32 rows to the Foundation, and 3 rows to <br> the Shawl Body. Yardage requirements will increase to approximately 410 yards for <br> +32 foundation and 590 yards for +64 foundation. |  |

3 Stitch Fan (3stFan) - (Ch 1, dc) 3 times, ch 1 in same st or sp

Special Stitches Chain 3 Loop (ch3Lp) - sc, ch 3 sc in same st or sp
Single Crochet/Double Treble Crochet ending stitch (sc/dtr endst) - insert hook in indicated st, yo, pull up lp, yo 3 times, insert hook in 2nd indicated st, yo, pull up lp, (yo pull thru 2 lps) 3 times, yo pull thru last 3 lps.

## Foundation Row

Row 1 With smaller hook, ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook. [1 sc]
Rows 2-169
Ch 1, turn, sc in first st. [169 sc]

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## Shawl Body

Row 1
With larger hook, ch 1, turn 90 degrees to work in side of foundation rows (referred to as sts), sc in first st, *sk 3 sts, 3 stFan in next st, sk 3 sts, 3chLp in next st,* repeat from * to * 9 times, sk 3 sts, 5stFan in next st, sk 3 sts, 3chLp in next st, repeat from * to * 9 times, sk 3 sts, 3 stFan in next st, sk 3 sts, sc in last st. [20 - 3stFans, 1 - 5stFan, 20 ch3Lps, 2 - sc]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next
Row 2 Fan,* repeat from * to * 9 times, ch 2, sk 1 dc, ch3Lp in next dc, repeat from * to * 9 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [20 - 3stFans, 20 - ch3Lps, 1 - ch-2 sp, 2 sc, 1 dtr]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next
Row 3 Fan,* repeat from * to * 9 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in ch-2 sp, repeat from * to * 9 times, 3 stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [20 - 3stFans, 19 - ch3Lps, 2 sc, 1dtr]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next
Row 4

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next Fan,* repeat from * to * 8 times, ch 2 , sk 1 dc, ch3Lp in next dc, repeat from * to * 8 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [18-3stFans, 18 - ch3Lps, 1 - ch-2 sp, 2 sc, 1 dtr]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next
Row 6

Row 7 Fan,* repeat from * to * 7 times, 5stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next Fan, repeat from * to * 7 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [16-3stFans, $1-5$ stFan, 16 ch3Lps, 2sc, 1 dtr]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next Row 8 Fan,* repeat from * to * 7 times, ch 2 , sk 1 dc, ch3Lp in next dc, repeat from * to * 7 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [16-3stFans, 16 - ch3Lps, 1 - ch- 2 sp, 2 sc, 1 dtr]

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Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next

[12-3stFans, $1-5 \mathrm{stFan}, 12$ ch3Lps, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dtr}]$

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next

## Row 14

 Fan,* repeat from * to * 5 times, ch 2 , sk 1 dc, ch3Lp in next dc, repeat from * to * 5 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [12-3stFans, 12 - ch3Lps, 1 - ch-2 sp, 2 sc, 1 dtr]Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next
Row 15 Fan,* repeat from * to * 4 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in ch-2 sp, repeat from * to * 5 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [12-3stFans, 11 - ch3Lps, 2 sc, 1dtr]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next Fan,* repeat from * to * 4 times, 5 stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next Fan, repeat from * to * 4 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [10-3stFans, $1-5$ stFan, 10 ch3Lps, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dtr}$ ]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next
Row 17 Fan,* repeat from * to * 4 times, ch 2, sk 1 dc, ch3Lp in next dc, repeat from * to * 4 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [10 - 3stFans, 10 - ch3Lps, 1 - ch-2 sp, 2 sc, 1 dtr]

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Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in 2nd dc of next Fan,* repeat from * to * 3 times, 3stFan in next ch-3 sp, ch3Lp in ch-2 sp, repeat from * to * 3 times, 3 stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2nd dc of next 3stFan and first sc of previous row. [10-3stFans, 9 - ch3Lps, 2 sc, 1dtr]

Final Edging Rows

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *3stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc in 2nd dc of next Row 19 fan,* repeat from * to * 4 times, 5stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc in 2nd dc of next fan, repeat from * to * 3 times, 3 stFan in next ch-3 sp, sc/dtr endst in 2 nd dc of next 3 stFan and first sc of previous row. [8-3stFans, 1 - 5stFan, 10 sc, 1 dtr]

Ch 5, turn, sc in 2nd dc of first 3stFan, *ch 4, sc in next sc, ch 4, sc in 2nd dc of next
Row 20 fan,* repeat from * to * 5 times, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, sc in same st, ch 3 sc in next dc, repeat from * to * 4 times, ch 5, sl st to last sc. Fasten off. [ 2 ch-5 sps, 16 ch-4 sps, 3 ch-3 spcs, 20 sc ]


## Finishing ...

Weave in ends. Wash and block as needed.
